Purpose of Evaluation: Education

1. Copy of a diploma from the University of Pune in Pune, India certifying that *Sample* was examined in Banking and Finance and Cost and Works Accounting, placed in the First Class in April 1996 and was conferred the degree of Bachelor of Commerce. This document was dated December 12, 1996, was signed by the Vice-Chancellor and is equivalent to three years of university-level credit from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States. Copies of a certificate verifying program information and Statements of Marks listing the coursework completed from 1995 through 1996, including the marks, were also submitted. Entrance into the three-year Bachelor of Commerce program requires completion of Standard XII in India, or the equivalent of graduation from High School in the United States. The University of Pune is a member of the Association of Indian Universities and is recognized by the University Grants Commission, the organization responsible for assessing complexity and assuring quality of degree programs in India. This recognition parallels regional accreditation of tertiary educational institutions in the United States. **Within this degree program, *Sample* earned the equivalent of a 3.44 (letter grade B+) cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 U.S. grading scale.**
2. Copy of a diploma from Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University in Nagpur, India certifying that *Sample* passed the Examination held in Summer 2007, placed in the First Division and was awarded the degree of Master of Computer Management. This document was dated September 3, 2007, was signed by the Vice-Chancellor and, in conjunction with the education described in paragraph #1, is equivalent to a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in management information systems from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States. Copies of a Post-Graduate Diploma in Computer Commercial Applications with a Statement of Marks verifying completion of the first year of graduate-level study and listing the coursework completed, including the marks, as well as a Provisional Degree Certificate verifying program information and a Statement of Marks listing the coursework completed in 2007, including the marks, were also submitted. Entrance into the two-year Master of Computer Management program requires an Indian bachelor's degree, such as the Bachelor of Commerce described in paragraph #1. Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University is a member of the Association of Indian Universities and is recognized by the University Grants Commission, the organization responsible for assessing complexity and assuring quality of degree programs in India. This recognition parallels regional accreditation of tertiary educational institutions in the United States. **Within this degree sequence, *Sample* earned the equivalent of a 3.36 (letter grade B+) cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 U.S. grading scale**
3. In summary, it is the judgment of the Foundation that *Sample* has the equivalent of a bachelor's degree in management information systems and a master's degree in management information systems from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States.
